Marie Crawford Scholarship kicked off January 1

The Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society Corp. has been chosen to administrate a scholarship fund created by SCV member James Moore Crawford of DeFuniak Springs, Fl. in memory of his wife Marie H. P. "Pilkie" Crawford. Mr. Crawford is a member of camp # 1541, and has been a member of the Sons of Confederate Veterans for over 50 years. This endowment will allow us to provide tuition expenses for at least two young adults to the Sam Davis Youth Camp. The winners will be selected by their winning essays on the topic of civility. Mrs. Crawford was the embodiment of civility, and her husband would like to see this gentle art carried forward into future generations of Southern young people.

The Scholarship is open to young lads & ladies from age 12 to 18. Essay competition commences on Jan.1 and runs until April 15th. Essay winners will be announced on April 15th to coincide with Confederate History Month. The topic of the essay will be Civility. New Legislation - **Amendment to the Order of Confederate Rose, Florida Society By-laws**

As of September 01, 2010, \$50.00 of every paid application received for life membership will be placed in a special contingency fund and the use of this fund will be designated by vote of the general assembly.

Award Nomination forms and criteria

All nominations must be submitted no later than April 15th to be considered no exceptions. All nominations must be either mailed or emailed to Barbara Harris. Nomination form is located at the end of this newsletter.

Certificate of Appreciation

Description of Award:

The Certificate of Appreciation Award is a certificate that is presented to an individual annually. More than one certificate may be awarded per year however only one certificate will be award per individual. Exceptions will be considered if an individual is nominated for multiple awards as a result of multiple activities. This award is presented to an individual that has supported the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society throughout the previous year. Nominations for this award are generated by Chapter Presidents or Executive Board Members. Nominations for this award will be reviewed by the Florida Society Executive Board who will vote based on the justification presented on the nomination form.

Qualifications to be nominated:

The nominee or group must have demonstrated support of the Order of Confederate Rose Chapter throughout the previous year.

How to nominate someone for this award:

Nominator must complete nomination form.

Nominator must submit completed form and back up documentation to State Secretary by April 15th of each year to be considered for the award ceremony at the State Re-Union to be held in May of that same year. Nomination must be completely filled out including signature. If nomination is submitted by email, the email address that it is being submitted from must be on the state roster or nomination will not be accepted.

Nominations must be submitted timely or they will not be considered for that year's award ceremony. If nomination is mailed by United States Postal Service, the postmaster's date stamp will be the deciding factor. If nomination is emailed, the mail server's date stamp will be the deciding factor. State Officer receiving nomination will not be responsible for misdirected nominations.

Chapter of the Year

Description of Award:

The Chapter of the Year Award is a certificate that is presented to one Chapter of the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society, annually. Only one certificate may be awarded per year. This award is presented to a Chapter that has performed an exemplary job above and beyond the call of duty throughout the previous year. Nominations for this award will be reviewed by the President of the Florida Society but the President is not limited to these nominations for her final decision of which chapter will receive this award.

Qualifications to be nominated:

The nominated chapter must be chartered for at least six months.

The nominated chapter must be in good standing with the Order of Confederate Rose Society.

The nominated chapter must have performed an exemplary job above and beyond the call of duty throughout the previous year as a unit.

How to nominate someone for this award:

Nominator must complete nomination form.

Nominator must submit completed form and back up documentation to State Secretary by April 15th of each year to be considered for the award ceremony at the State Re-Union to be held in May of that same year. Nomination must be completely filled out including signature. If nomination is submitted by email, the email address that it is being submitted from must be on the state roster or nomination will not be accepted.

Nominations must be submitted timely or they will not be considered for that year's award ceremony. If nomination is mailed by United States Postal Service, the postmaster's date stamp will be the deciding factor. If nomination is emailed, the mail server's date stamp will be the deciding factor. State Officer receiving nomination will not be responsible for misdirected nominations.

Life-time Achievement

Description of Award:

The Life-time Achievement Award is a certificate and a trophy that is rarely presented. This award is presented only to an individual that have given their life to the cause of the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society. Once this award is given, the individual will never be eligible to receive this award again. Nominations for this award will be reviewed by the President of the Florida Society but the President is not limited to these nominations for her final decision of who will receive this award if any award is granted for the year.

Qualifications to be nominated:

The nominee must be a member of the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society for at least five years.

The nominee must be in good standing with the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society.

The nominee must have performed an exemplary job above and beyond the call of duty as a member of the Society and given their life to the Cause of the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society.

How to nominate someone for this award:

Nominator must complete nomination form.

Nominator must submit completed form and back up documentation to State Secretary by April 15th of each year to be considered for the award ceremony at the State Re-Union to be held in May of that same year. Nomination must be completely filled out including signature. If nomination is submitted by email, the email address that it is being submitted from must be on the state roster or nomination will not be accepted.

Nominations must be submitted timely or they will not be considered for that year's award ceremony. If nomination is mailed by United States Postal Service, the postmaster's date stamp will be the deciding factor. If nomination is emailed, the mail server's date stamp will be the deciding factor. State Officer receiving nomination will not be responsible for misdirected nominations.

Rose of the Year

The Rose of the Year Award is a certificate and a medal that is presented to one member of the Order of Confederate of the Rose Florida Society annually. Nominations for this award will be reviewed by the President of the Florida Society but the President is not limited to these nominations for her final decision of who will receive this award.

Qualifications to be nominated:

The nominee must be a member of the Order of Confederate Rose for at least one year.

The nominee must be in good standing with the Order of Confederate Rose.

The nominee must have performed an exemplary job above and beyond the call of duty as a member of the Society throughout the pervious year.

How to nominate someone for this award:

Nominator must complete nomination form.

Nominator must submit completed form and back up documentation to State Secretary by April 15th of each year to be considered for the award ceremony at the State Re-Union to be held in May of that same year. Nomination must be completely filled out including signature. If nomination is submitted by email, the email address that it is being submitted from must be on the state roster or nomination will not be accepted.

Nominations must be submitted timely or they will not be considered for that year's award ceremony. If nomination is mailed by United States Postal Service, the postmaster's date stamp will be the deciding factor. If nomination is emailed, the mail server's date stamp will be the deciding factor. State Officer receiving nomination will not be responsible for misdirected nominations.

Qualifications to be nominated:

The nominated SCV Camp must have demonstrated outstanding support of the Order of Confederate Rose Florida Society throughout the previous year.

How to nominate someone for this award:

Nominator must complete nomination form.

Nominator must submit completed form and back up documentation to State Secretary by April 15th of each year to be considered for the award ceremony at the State Re-Union to be held in May of that same year. Nomination must be completely filled out including signature. If nomination is submitted by email, the email address that it is being submitted from must be on the state roster or nomination will not be accepted.

Nominations must be submitted timely or they will not be considered for that year's award ceremony. The nominee must perform an exemplary job at promoting the education of the truth of the Confederacy to youth throughout the previous year.

How to nominate someone for this award:

Nominator must complete nomination form.

Nominator must submit completed form and back up documentation to State Secretary by April 15th of each year to be considered for the award ceremony at the State Re-Union to be held in May of that same year. Nomination must be completely filled out including signature. If nomination is submitted by email, the email address that it is being submitted from must be on the state roster or nomination will not be accepted.
